

CPMA Regulations

Woodbine Entertainment Group is the association conducting pari-mutuel betting at this location.

Pari-Mutuel betting and drug control services are provided under the supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel agency, an agency of Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, under the supervision of the Minister of Agriculture. All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the Pari-Mutuel Supervision Regulations. In Ontario, no persons under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. WEG issues tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario M9W 5L2. Pari-Mutuel Supervision Regulations permit the cancellation of bets, until stop betting, for reasons including:

- A change in race surface, race distance, track condition or jockey
- A scratch of part of an entry and the cancel time limit expired at a self-serve machine
- A wrong ticket, even after you have left the mutual window

Any bets purchased can be cancelled at any machine within 40 seconds. Bets purchased up to \$100 via a Self-Serve machine can be cancelled at any time until pools close. Any Bets can be cancelled at a Teller until pools close. Wagers placed by the telephone must be cancelled by calling the HorsePlayer Interactive support centre at (416) 675-8886 or toll free at 1-888-675-8886. HPI and Cash Card wagering have no **cancel limits**.

For **WIN tickets of \$200.00 or more after 40 seconds**, you must take the ticket to a teller:

- Print your NAME (first and surname) and phone number clearly on the back of the ticket (before presenting to the teller)
- Present government-issued photo identification to a teller or voucher seller

All cancelled bets will be closely monitored.

Subject to the Regulations, all monies on all pools on a race are refunded in the event the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a betting interest are refunded if the betting interest is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and websites. The Double, Pick 3, Pick 4, and Pick 5 pools are not refunded after the first leg has been declared official. The following pools will be refunded if the following occur:

- Pick 3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel
- Pick 4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel

Where a betting interest that is part of an entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one betting interest of that entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

***Odds of 1-9 may pay a price as low as \$2.10 based on a \$2 bet. Odds of 99-1 may pay a price higher than \$200 based on a \$2 bet.**

Odds represent the probably pay-out price at the time and have no bearing on the pay-out price on any other pool.
