TELLER CANCEL DELAY NOTIFICATION
Some jurisdictions participating in foreign part-mutuel pools offer what is called a "teller cancel delay".
This practice permits tellers to cancel a bet up to 10 seconds after the start of a race. The purpose of the "teller cancel delay" is to allow tellers to cancel mis-issued bets but has the effect of delaying the transmission of final part-mutuel pools, which in turn delays the posting of final odds. Should a significant cancellation occur, payouts on winning bets may be affected?

BREAKAGE
All prices in Canada must be broken to the nickel as per section 204 of the Criminal Code of Canada, whereas many tracks in the U.S. and abroad break to a dime. As a result, WEG prices may pay a nickel more or less on a one dollar price.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATIONLEVY
WEG deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, foreign host track, simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission. Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except 4% on trifecta wagering. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
