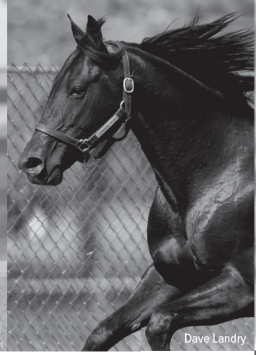

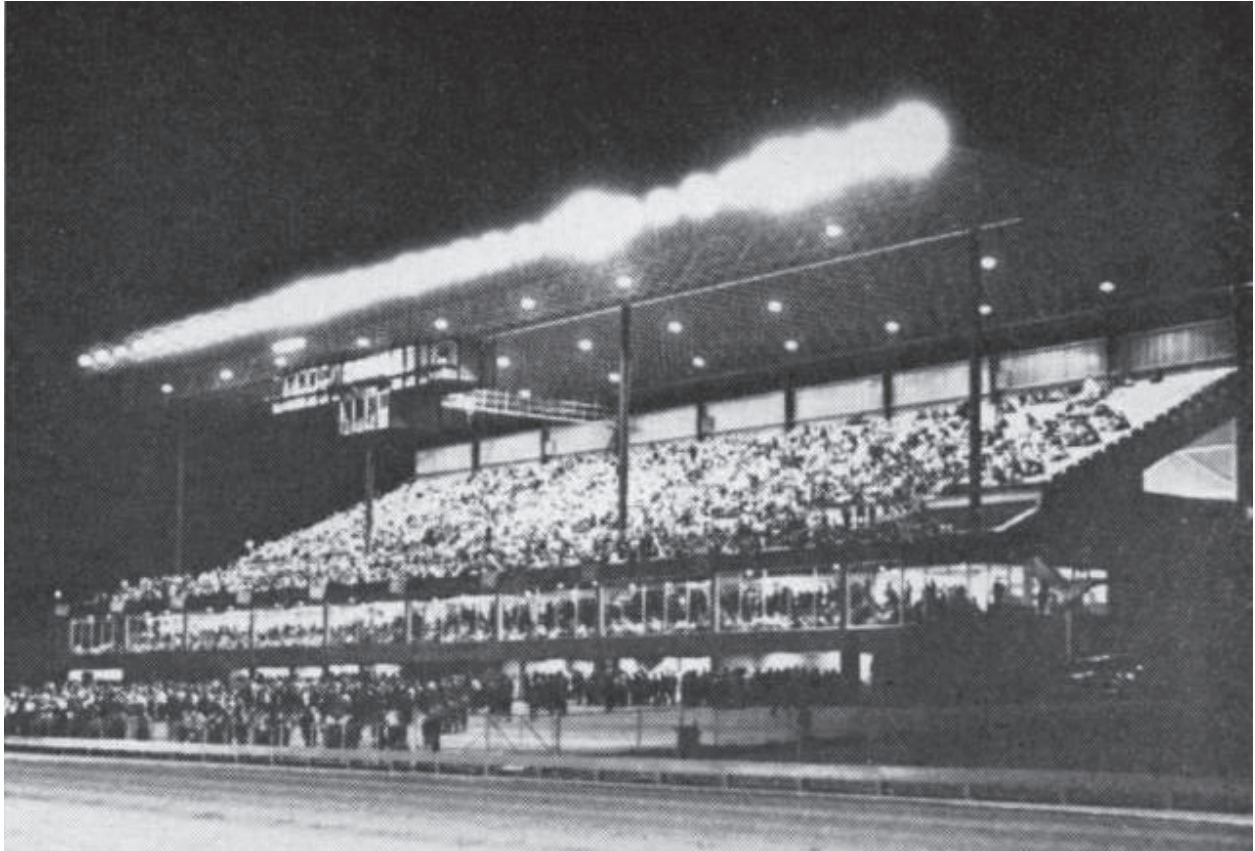

OSS 50th Anniversary: A look back at Rideau Carleton Raceway, an original OSS 'A' track

Rideau Carleton, which was opened in 1962, was one of six "A" tracks chosen to present OSS action in that first year. An excerpt from an article in the Ottawa Citizen prior to the first OSS visit said, "It's doubtful whether there has been as much interest in harness racing in the area since the sport was revived around here in 1953."

On Monday, Aug. 5, 1974 the Ontario Sires Stakes made their first of four visits to the Rideau track that season. To celebrate the occasion, the season's largest crowd was on hand as 3,571 fans attended the Albion Road track. The large gathering wagered a healthy \$172,771, also a season's high.

On this day, the three-year-old pacing colts and geldings were in the spotlight, many of the same performers who had kicked off the OSS competition just a month previous to this at the Garden City track in St. Catharines.

With the race divided into two divisions, each with a purse of around \$ 27,000, a total of 18 sophomore pacing colts went post-ward. In the opener, a horse with local connections, Paul Bye Pat, was the winner for E.S. Scarff Stables of Ottawa, with Jim Miller driving.

In the second tilt, it was again Terry Parker for owner driver Clint Hodgins with Paula's Peanut second for Wm. Wellwood in a swift 2:03.4. This group of colts and geldings were quickly becoming fan favorites wherever they appeared.

The wagering on the four visits that first year of the OSS totalled over \$552,000, with a daily average of \$138,000, well above the \$110,000 average for the meeting. It was very clear from the start that the level of competition and the appearance of named colt performers, drivers and stables appealed to the betting public.

OSS Scrapbook Memories

R B Jet is shown with Norm Jones in the sulky. This trotting colt sired by Armbro Jet out of the Hoot Mon mare Armbro Audrey had two great seasons in the early days of the OSS. Starting at age two in 1976, he chalked up 11 wins in 15 starts for \$ 82,633 in earnings. The following year he continued to dominate Ontario's best, winning 15 of 19 starts. He was never worse than third that season as he earned \$93,922. He retired as the richest Canadian-sired trotter in history winning almost \$594,000. He was owned by his trainer and driver in partnership with Ray Bodi of Lyndhurst, Ont., located in the Rideau area.

In 1983, Brisco Herbert led all three-year-old trotting colts with earnings of \$115,000 in OSS action, and \$156,620 total. He also became the first trotter to break the 2:00 barrier in the history of the Ontario program. Owned by Ruth Herbert of London and handled by Dave Wall, the new mile record was clocked at 1:59.4 in early August at Rideau Carleton.

The combination of the long-standing Herbert name and that of a then-young trainer and driver Dave Wall proved to be a winning formula.

Armbro Sonnet and driver Joe O'Brien are seen here after notching a win. This filly had an amazing year in 1977, posting several wins in OSS action. In late October they went to Rideau Carleton and set a new track record for three-year-old trotting fillies. Their mark of 2:03.1 erased the former one held by Mia Herbert of 2:05.3. This win ended a six-win streak for Shawland Dawn and driver Larry Walker. This new time was the fastest ever trotted by an Ontario Sired three-year-old trotting filly or colt at this time in history.

A crowd of 2,305 fans were on hand to watch the event, which carried a purse of \$39,293. This filly had spent time at the Arnprior farm of local horseman Jim McCormick, who stated after the race, "I think all that Ottawa Valley air had something to do with how well she raced." This

marked just the second appearance at Rideau for Joe O'Brien and his second win having scored the previous season with Armbro Ranger in the Ryan Memorial.

In 1985, Lou Macs Dream, the son of Dream of Glory – Ruthie, trotted his way into the record books thanks in part to his numerous victories in OSS events. Trained and driven by Garth Gordon, this fellow won over \$100,000 that season.

This colt was a \$28,000 purchase by his owner Walter Emond of Etobicoke Ont. At season's end, he was the fastest colt in his class with a record of 1:59.3 taken at Rideau Carleton. The Ontario Sires Stakes was then in its 12th year and continued to provide a lot of racing and earning possibilities for Ontario-breds. In 1984, the Gordon stable had the season's champion three-year-old filly trotter Anken Contessa for owner Ken Ewen of Georgetown, Ont. She emerged as the highest money winner in her OSS category.

Dallas Princess and driver Carman Hie are shown in winning form during the 1986 season. This then-three-year-old filly by Dallas Almahurst rewrote history when she paced the fastest mile in OSS competition covering the first 13 years, with her 1:53.4 mile setting a new standard. At season's end, she was the highest money earner in the three-year-old filly division with \$118,092 banked, leading all pacers, regardless of age or gender, in money won. One of her wins that season came at Rideau Carleton in late September in an OSS event which carried a purse of \$41,285. In that one, she edged out another top filly, Armbro Eva, handled by Reg Gassien in a winning time of 1:58.2.

Bred by the famed Killean Acres of Ingersoll, this filly was owned and trained by Ed Lahey of Cambridge, Ont. In a recent chat, Carman said, "What I remember about this filly is that she could not leave fast, but she always finished fast."

Pictured here is N V Worthy and driver-trainer Robert Walker. An outstanding performer for owners Clarence and Norma Varcoe of Alliston, Ont., as a two-year-old in 1986, this young trotter recorded a mile in 2:00 even while he was on his way to being the leader in his class by virtue of his \$114,712 in purse winnings.

One of his victories was at the Rideau track at the end of August. Race fans were treated by seeing N V Worthy win one division while Armbro Fame notched his 11th victory in a row with Bill Wellwood in the sulky for owner John Grant of Hornby, Ont. Armbro Fame's time of 2:01 flat was a new track record, erasing the 2:02.4 set four years previously by Spikenard, also in an OSS event.

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

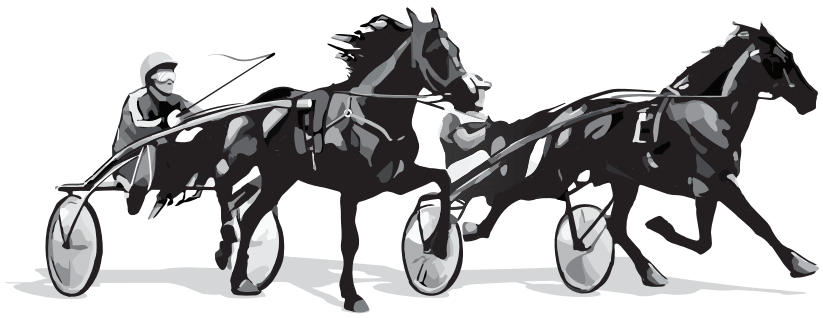

Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Pari-mutuel wagering and drug control services are provided under the supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency, an agency of the Ministry of Agriculture. All wagering pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the Pari-Mutuel Betting Regulations.

Rules and Information Regarding Canadian Harness and Foreign Separate Pool Events

General

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. No person under the age 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher. A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty-four hours of buying or cashing valid ticket or voucher. No rules made by the judges or AGCO with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-outs or distributions of pari-mutuel pools. Program changes and e photo finishes pictures are shown on the televisions. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

Super Hi 5 Betting

A betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first five horses representing different betting interests to finish, the exact official order of finish in the race on which the feature is operated. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current pool will be carried over to the next Super Hi feature.

Pick 4 and Pick 3

The Pick 4 and Pick 3 features are betting transactions in which the purchaser undertakes to select the winner of four or three successive races respectively. In the event selected horse is scratched, the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch(es) occurred, will be substituted for the non starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non starting selection. **However, if a scratch occurs in any leg a Pick pool before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.**

Association Percentage and Taxation/Levy

Pick 4, Pick 5 & Super High 5 11.7%, Trifecta 21.95%, all other wagers 20.75%. Additionally, Ontario Provincial Levy 2% on all pools, except 4% trifecta pools. Ontario Government retains 0.5% on all bets. The Federal government through a revolving fund cost recovery basis retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control and audit services.

Federal Regulations Amendment

In the unlikely event that the prices are posted which are based on an incorrect official order of finish, associations must immediately stop paying the erroneous prices, recalculate and pay the correct price including correction of all account-based wagers.

For wagers, no matter what the cause, which cannot be combined into the host track's pools before the end of the race; federal regulations require that such bets must be refunded.

Payment of wagers will be made only on the presentation of a valid pari-mutuel tickets.

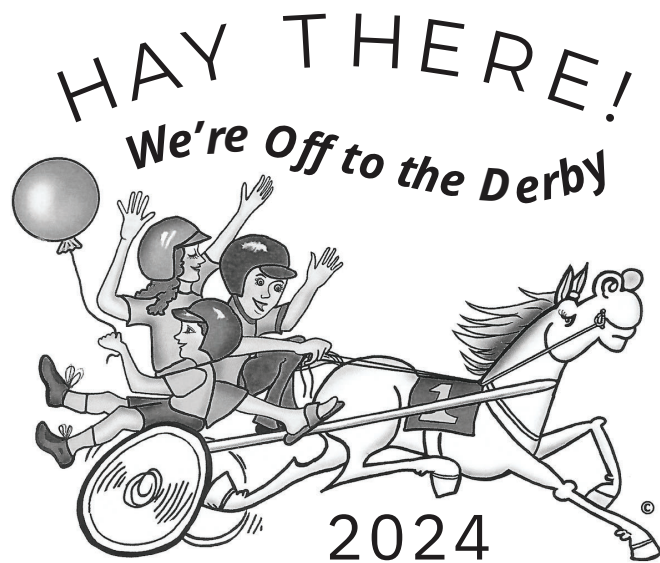
